More recently the transacting public were cautious in accepting the RBZ's 18th December 2014 bond coins such that up to now (May 2015) some sections of the economy are still not accepting it as a medium of exchange; more than 4 months after introduction. This essay tries to briefly highlight some of the reasons why (in both instances) economic agents rejected or attempted to reject the currency available to them despite the logic behind such decisions by the RBZ. It is argued in this essay that reasons for which the economic agents (here in Zimbabwe) rejected or attempt to reject the currency available to them are fundamentally rooted on the New Classical school of thought. 12 pp. Englisch.
